I was diagnosed with breast cancer in January of this year, and after surgery was given a huge amount of invaluable support and advice, not to mention really beneficial treatments, at the Haven in Fulham. It made a huge difference to my recovery, and played a vital part in helping me to deal with this trauma, teaching me how to improve the various side effects of my medication.

As you know, breast cancer is practically at epidemic proportions now, and it would be truly lamentable if the UK's capital city has nowhere for patients to go - to get additional help and advice and treatments. I do hope you will do everything in your power to ensure this doesn't happen.
