It would be very dangerous also for the safety in a case of emergency.

I have been asked to send this email on the night of yesterday but because I had an emergency related to work, I was not able to do so and I would ask you to forgive me and accept this as prove and declaration of a state of emergency for the people occupying the properties interested in this case and that this will be a great help in bringing it to a reversal decision and having the unapproved extension removed.
