I wish to register my support for the application.

Rima's bakery has provided the community with excellent baked goods, however, with such a business model becoming subject to increasing levels of competition (e.g. Gails Bakery opening earlier this year), it is clear that the change of use would be both to the benefit of the proprietor and the wider community in Kentish Town.

I welcome the potential increase in the selection of hot and cold food on the high street, provided by a family run business.

To obfuscate the true intentions of the application as only "chicken and pizza" is highly misleading, as the application notes that "It is anticipated as well as potentially the sale of hot food there will be other food options available including salads, hot sandwiches, hot and cold drinks."
