Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Birch (T1): Reduce crown height by 20%, reduce lateral and sublateral growth over neighbouring property by 20-25% and thin crown density by 20%.

1 x Birch (T2): Thin crown density by 10%.

1 x Birch (T3): Twin-stemmed: Reduce rear stem height by 15%, reduce front stem by 20% and thin crown density by 20%

FRONT GARDEN: Pittosporum - Reduce crown by up to 10%

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 24 September 2018 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by



the Council.

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
