Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended) NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A **CONSERVATION AREA**

Address: 7 Hampstead Hill Gardens London **NW3 2PH**

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Hornbeam (T1) - Reduce crown by approximately 30%, thin crown density by 25%.

1 x Laurel (T2) - Fell to ground level and grind stump to approximately 300mm below current ground level

1 x Laurel (T3) - Remove low branch protruding over the lawn, reduce remaining overhang bv 20%.

1 x Yew (T4) (Pruned into hedge form) - Reduce height by 20-25% and reduce overhang by 20%.

1 x Yew (T5) (Large and rose covered) - Reduce extraneous rose throngs back into main crown structure and reduce/trim the lower, currently exposed, section of the crown by 20%.

Group consisting of Holly, Lilac, Hawthorn and Yew forming hedge line to the rear boundary (G1) - Reduce overhang by 30%.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 27 September 2018 and does not wish to object.
