PARTIAL DISCHARGE OF CONDITION 8 OF LISTED BUILDING CONSENT 2015/6937/P

On behalf of my client, Consolidated Developments Ltd, please find enclosed an application to part discharge Condition 8 attached to Listed Building Consent 2015/6937/P. Please note that parts a) and b) have already been discharged under planning application reference 2018/3567/L.

Condition 8 states:

Detailed drawings, or samples of materials as appropriate, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority before the relevant part of the work is begun:

- a) New fireplaces;
