Further to my email below, I have been provided with the following maintenance statement in regards to the plant climber (condition 7 of planning permission 2015/4408/P application ref: 2018/4129/P):

“Water the plant regularly in its first season, while it is getting established, and in following years in dry spells. Use a simple wire system to train the climber onto the wall, until it develops aerial roots. This may take two to three seasons. Once firmly attached plants will climb vigorously. Once the desired height is reached trim the top level in early spring, and at other times of year if necessary. Pruning of established plants is best kept to a minimum, but as plants fill their space, shorten overlong shoots and outward-growing laterals by cutting them back to a healthy bud. Do this after flowering, which is between early summer and autumn.”
