1/ Robinia psuedoacacia; the tree is approximately 10 metres high and approximately 40 years old, it leans out across some garages towards the main road. The crown looks fairly healthy though there are significant amounts of deadwood in it. The base of the tree on the side facing the garage shows significant areas of decay and there is a detached fruiting by the tree suggesting internal decay. The application is to fell the tree due to its position and the acute angle of lean, I don't believe reduce the crown would remove enough weight, though the owners would be happy to retain it if the council thinks it is safe

There is open access to the area where the tree is situated as the house is being refurbished
