We believe that the proposed development will affect our quality of life and downgrade the look and feel of the area.  St Johns Wood is a traditionally green area, not a concrete jungle. Such a big block will inevitably lead to loss of privacy and loss of sunlight in flats of adjoining or adjacent buildings while causing loss of parking spaces. The noise disturbance alone during the long construction will be unbearable for local residents. How would this issue be resolved, if permission was granted.</p> <p>Finally, the issue surrounding the legal right of passage for residents of Middlefield has yet to be addressed and agreed.
