Notes

The construction operations area consists of the hatched area for special protection measures and the area contained within the barrier fencing and south of the existing building. The footprint of the existing building can also be considered to be part of the construction operations area. All construction operations must take place entirely within this area to protect the root zones of existing trees on site.
