- The AQ monitoring locations are suitable in respect of prevailing atmospheric conditions, key
  nearby receptors and dust-generating activities on the site Confirmed. Air monitors will be
  positioned in order to capture dust-generating activities while considering atmospheric conditions, to
  best measure exposure at key nearby receptors. Given the nature of the work and constantly
  changing landscape, monitors may need to be moved during the course of demolition to avoid
  obstructions, damage and obtain realistic results
- Both monitor positions are free from potential obstructions and are in line with sources of dust on either side of the site boundary Confirmed. As per the above.
