Dear Tree Team,

Following receipts of the two proposed notices Ref 2018/5540/T for the felling of 1x Chestnut Tree and 1x Robina tree at the rear garden. My wife and I would like to **strongly object** to the proposed works on the following grounds:

- 1) They are two beautiful trees which have been in Hampstead for a very long period and not only add character to the area are a home to the rapidly diminishing wildlife including rare birds
- 2) The trees do not pose any risk whatsoever to any of the adjoining properties and provide privacy cover for the surrounding houses
- 3) The only reason for the destruction of these trees is so the owner can build on the land - which they have been trying to do for the last 20 years
- 4) My wife and I moved to Hampstead due to the strong conservation nature and the beautiful heath. This act represents simply destruction of the natural surroundings for profit - something which goes completely against the Conservation Area principles
- 5) As members of the Heath and Hampstead Society we are committed to keeping Hampstead free from unnecessary destruction which this represents
