## **Introduction**

The following report, drawings and specification have been prepared by Anne French & Associates Landscape Designers in conjunction with STW and BYUK.

The design for the landscaping proposal, title 'The Apothecary's Garden' was presented to UCLH on the 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2018. Please refer to BYUK Minutes of Meeting and has now been updated to post review of the Camden Biodiversity Plan and BREEAM requirements – see note below.

The presentation covered the following areas:

- 1) Overall scope and extent of soft landscaping – sedum landscaping was not included and forms part of STW Roofing & Soft Landscape Report - P4PBT-STW-ALL-SL-REP-A31-101091 - Rev G
- 2) Explanation of the concept of the Apothecary's Garden, types of plants and overall approach to planting.
- 3) Maintenance issues.
- 4) Integration of the landscaping into the wider building design.

Overall the response from the Trust was positive with some queries regarding the planting types (toxic plants to be removed) and irrigation and maintenance requirements. These have been addressed in the attached documents.

## **Camden Biodiversity Plan:**

The soft landscaping proposals and planting types have been reviewed against Camden's Biodiversity Plan and against our BREEAM requirements.

The resultant BREEAM Report is attached here as Appendix B - 181002 OBOU110 UCLH Breeam Reassessment RH FA PF 008

Item 4.1.7 assumes that the extensive green roof habitats will incorporate at least 8 native species. This has now been added to our specification.

As per criterion 3c of BREEAM issue LE 05, the landscape maintenance plan has also been updated to make reference to the Camden Biodiversity Action Plan. This is in the attached document - Soft Landscape Maintenance Plan.

*Melica altissima 'Alba'*



*Nepeta racemosa 'Walker's Low'*  
Carminative, tonic, diaphoretic, refrigerant and slightly emmenagogue, specially antispasmodic, and mildly stimulating.



*Origanum laevigatum 'Herrenhausen'*  
Its properties are stimulant, carminative, diaphoretic and mildly tonic; a useful emmenagogue. It is so acrid that it has been employed not only as a rubefacient, and often as a liniment.



*Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln'*



*Rosmarinus prostratus*  
Tonic, astringent, diaphoretic, stimulant. Oil of Rosemary has the carminative properties of other volatile oils and is an excellent stomachic and nervine, curing many cases of headache.



*Stachys officinalis 'Hummelo'*  
Stimulant, astringent, tonic and carminative.



*Salvia officinalis 'Purpurascens'*  
Stimulant, astringent, tonic and carminative.



*Stipa tenuissima*



*Trifolium rubens*  
The fluid extract of Trifolium is used as an alterative and antispasmodic. An infusion may be used in cases of bronchial and whooping-cough. Fomentations and poultices of the herb have been used as local applications to cancerous growths.




*Thymus serpyllum 'Pink Chintz'*  
It is aromatic, antiseptic, stimulant, antispasmodic, diuretic and emmenagogue.


