I have been unable to gain access to the garden, but have viewed from the road and emailed the new owner. I have read Dr Martin Dobson's report don't object to any of the work applied for being carried out. I see that permission was refused for work on the holm oak 7 years ago, but presume it wasn't as diseased as now.

I would like to suggest that if felled, the elm should be replaced by a Dutch Elm resistant tree, such as *Ulmus lutece*, as planted by David Attenborough in Waterlow Park. Also that the ivy is removed from many of the trees.
