Our concerns are as follows:</p> <p>Concerned about VSC light ratio reduction to 0.78, which violates suggested target of 0.8, and the ADF value which is below the recommendation for a bedroom (results detailed on p16/17 of the Daylight and Sunlight Report</p> <p>Concerned that they have not reviewed light reduction to our skylights on the roof of our second floor and would like to see an assessment of this</p> <p>Concerned that building works will occur when we are expecting to have a newborn (birth expected early July 2019), and will create unhealthy levels of noise and dust in our flat, which is directly adjacent to the property</p> <p>Concerned about impact on privacy in our flat. Will the inhabitants of 108 Fortune Green Road and the Ingham road properties be able to see into our windows, particularly on the back of [REDACTED]</p> <p>Thank you for your consideration.
