Once again I write to object to yet another planning application for 6 Albert Terrace Mews NW1 7T.

My family has lived almost opposite 6 Albert Terrace since 1946.

I am not an architect, and am losing sight of the details of the complicated ambitions for 6 Albert Terrace Mews and - joined by a garden - 6 Albert Terrace. I could struggle to find the time to make detailed objections, which I know is what planners are obliged to take notice of:

e.g.,

- potential underground development
- loss of housing, against Camden's own housing policy
- a high wall
- a swimming pool
- effects on the water table of various 'basements'
- disruption of traffic, including our only bus, the 274
- noise, filth and inconvenience to neighbours etc.

I am, however, losing the energy to do this - which is precisely what rich and persistent owner/developers hope ordinary neighbours will do. Skilled architects put in piecemeal and ever-modified proposals until we are worn down by attrition.

Once again I object to the evident ambition to create a Super Home, totally inappropriate to this Conservation Area.
