Front garden T1 Irish Yew x 1 (Taxus baccata fastigiata) Large Semi-mature Irish yew tree in the front garden of No.26 Lyndhurst Road. One of two Yew trees at the entrance to the property. This one has a larger spread of the two but also a sparse and unhealthy crown. Suggested works: In an attempt to form 2 uniform trees of equal size and vigour, this tree should be reduced by 2.5-3 meters to match the neighbouring tree. The target is to force the tree into a state of shock, thus forming a more compact and dense crown.
