I am writing on behalf of Kentish Town Road Action, a group that seeks to improve Kentish Town Road in all its aspects. KTRA objects to this planning application for the Installation of a telephone kiosk on the Pavement Outside 197 Kentish Town Road NW5 2JU.

Kentish Town Road Action is objecting to this GPDO Prior Approval Determination application on the grounds of Design. This application for a hideous black panel, with no design merit at all, must be refused. The panel is effectively no more than a huge advertising board. It would be distracting and dangerous for motorists. It would block up the pavement and create an increase in unnecessary street furniture.

If this application were permitted it would threaten the viability and vitality of this frontage, and of Kentish Town Centre as a whole, because of it's looming ugly design.

KTRA is asking you to refuse this application for the reasons given above.
