

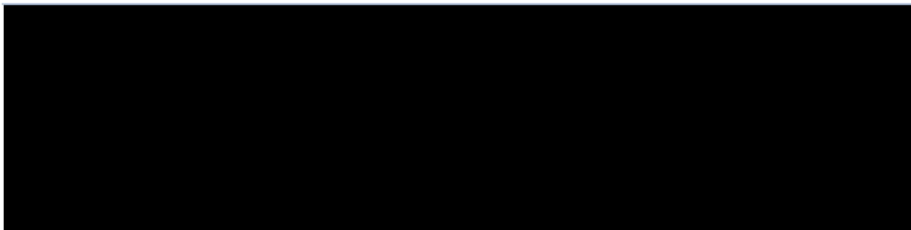
Dear David,
