I've just received notification of the following applications:

Both applications are from the same applicant at 3 Nutley Terrace.

Can the Council confirm that, in regards to the Fitzjohn's Ave. application for the horse chestnut tree, that this tree does not (as stated in the application) have a TPO? And if any work is to be done, will there be any oversight from the Council for this tree? This mature horse chestnut is on council land, and part of a much-loved area of small woodland, which is of great amenity to residents, despite having been in part subject to unnecessary tree felling in recent years, to assist nearby property developments.
