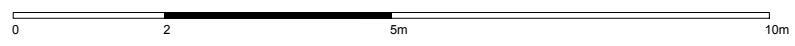




SCHEDULE OF PROPOSED WORKS

- 1. Reinstatement of arched window in original opening, to replace existing modern window. Arched opening and frame to match original windows as evident on neighbouring properties No. 104 and no. 106 Chetwynd Road. Existing brickwork re-used to form reduced width opening.
- 2. Existing corroded timber windows to be replaced with new timber windows to match existing.
- 3. New brick pier and gate as shown on drawing PL-04.
- 4. General de-cluttering works to wall- redundant services removed and drainage rationalised.
- 5. Existing opening infilled with render finish to external face to match existing, and partially set back to maintain profile of existing opening.

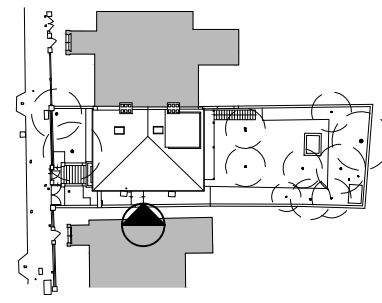
