- remove all sucker growth at trunk base to ground level
- cut back branches overhanging pavement close to boundary line

(T2) - Elder (*Sambucus*)

- reduce by 25%(1.8m) to suitable growth points to re-shape to balanced canopy line

(T3) - Irish Yew (*Taxus baccata 'Fastigiata'*)

- fell to ground level as front garden will be re landscaped and replanting proposed.

(T4) - Lime (*Tilia cordata*) - double - stemmed

- reduce to previous points of reduction
- remove all epicormic growth to primary crown break

(T5) - Evergreen Magnolia (*M. grandiflora*)

- reduce long branch back to natural canopy line (retain lateral side growth)

(T6) - Holly (*Ilex*)

- light reduction by 1m and trim sides to match

(T7) - Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) - dbl stem from primary crown break

- remove all ivy from upper crown stems to 1m below crown break
- remove all deadwood and carry out full aerial inspect inspection to check for visible evidence of ash 'Chalara' die-back

(T10) - Elder (*Sambucus*) - growing mostly outbound over neighbouring property

- fell to ground level as this has grown out of shape and is in poor condition - replanting is planned into the redevelopment of the garden.

(T11) - Pear (*Pyrus*)

- reduce crown by 25%(1.3m) to suitable growth points
- thin by 15% to clean inner crown to allow more air/light through tree

(T12) - Silver Birch (*Betula pendula*)

- reduce crown by 20%(1.6m) to suitable growth points

All reduction works are for routine maintenance.
