I was subsequently witness to a successful break-in to the neighbouring property, Spencer House. The thieves had observed during the daytime a possible course of access through The South Fairground and later that night successfully made their way through it, resulting in the burglary of My immediate reaction was to put up 'blinds' in order to prevent any future recurrence. This was the only time I could admit to personal failing in my duty as a security guard, and it has lain on my conscience.

In 2010, I was approached on two separate occasions, by two separate persons of different nationality, who both claimed ownership of The South Fairground Site, and asked to vacate the premises. Since the name Frishman alone would have been sufficient for me to acknowledge the rightful termination of my verbal contract with Mr Frishman senior in late 2004, I asked them both to show proof of their identity by the simplest means (driver's licence, bus pass etc.).

Both parties avoided the opportunity to identify themselves as the rightful owner, and furthermore neither re-established contact thereafter – either in person or in writing – until 24th of August 2016, when I received the notice of trespass that was issued on 10th of August 2016. By delaying delivery of the notice for two weeks Whistlers Development have put the gathering of evidence and witnesses to the truth of our case at a disadvantage, which further adds to my disappointment at the lack of communication between Mr Frishman Junior and myself.

Since I have not heard from anybody claiming to be Mr Frishman Senior or his inheritor since the approach of the two individuals mentioned in 2010, I was shocked and saddened by the blunt accusation of my trespass and wrong-doing.

In my twelve years of living here on The South Fairground Site, I have never been made aware of any potential disturbance to the neighbourhood, either through writing, telephone, or verbally. Furthermore I will bear witness to the fact that I have never had a single party or gathering of people for any reason, since I am known to be a private, humble and respectful person.
