2018/5935/T	M Michaelson	06/12/2018 11:27:48	OBJ	<p>I am writing to object to Application No: 2018/5935/T 17a Belsize Lane, NW3 5AD , regarding the request to fell to ground level 1 x Arbutus (T2).</p> <p>This magnificent and stunning evergreen specimen is an asset to the entire streetscape of Belsize Lane and Orrian Road. It has a significant level of visual amenity and makes a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area.</p> <p>In my written comment to the application 2017/0894/P on 21/03/2017, I warned that the application for a large ground floor extension extending into the side garden of the property would put this tree at risk. To quote, this is what I wrote then,</p> <p>'I am also concerned that the majestic and mature strawberry tree (Arbutus Unedo) beside the western wall close to the existing kitchen is not mentioned in the plans or drawings, and that it may be put at risk. This tree is clearly visible in the photos in para 7, 8 & 9 of the Design and Access Statement.'</p> <p>I believe that if this tree is perceived now as 'becoming somewhat large for its location' as stated in the application, it should not be felled. I have no objection if it is pruned or thinned sympathetically to fit into its location, including some of the overhang onto the pavement.</p>
