We write to support the original plans for the replacement windows to the top floor of 10 York Rise as submitted by the owners Deborah and Heini Schneebeil. We understand these plans were accepted but then objected to by Camden's Conservation Officer. In particular we are concerned that the revised counter proposals by Camden's Conservation officer will mean that the rear windows will be higher than under the owners' original proposal which lowered their height, and will thus cause more overlooking onto our roof terrace. The less glass the better from our point of view.

We would be gratefully if you would consider this point and revert to the original proposal.
