## Informative(s):

Details of plants and planter boxes have been submitted in relation to condition 4 of planning permission (2015/2786/P) dated 09/11/2015. The submitted details are considered sufficient to prevent unreasonable overlooking from the upper ground floor roof terrace to adjacent windows, and are appropriate in terms of design and materials with regard to the character and appearance of the host building and the wider area.

A Council Tree & Landscape Officer has also reviewed the submitted details and found them sufficient to demonstrate that the plant species are suitable for the purposes of providing sustainable screening that enhances the biodiversity of the site and can be satisfactoriy maintained as such. The details are

therefore considered to be acceptable.
