More space is needed due to the growing of the church and communities. I helped the Wednesday missionary in the church called "Chicken Chow Mein" in 2014-15, which helped the local homeless people and provided free food to them. Due to the size of the church hall, and limitation of kitchen and welfare facilities in the church, we could only accommodate upto around 30 people every time, although we found that more than 30 homeless people are needed in the local area. Similarly, our Winter Shelter project also needs that our church would have more space to accommodate more people who need help from our church. Furthermore, the number of children is growing in the church. There are not enough rooms and space the church provided for the children who need to take the Sunday school classes. It forces some children to play outside the church building on the street, and potentially causes risks because there are many cars and vehicles near our church. I wish that the church redevelopment project can go ahead, which can utilitise the space, upgrade the facilities and safety, and hence help the local people and communities further.

				 (1)The original arch design over front gate, and window edge can be transplanted to the new design. These are merely superficial, minor alterations, that won't materially augment construction costs. (2)Street front of top roof edge could bend inwards a bit so to be in line with the roof edges of neighboring buildings (left and right). (3)Surface texture could be made similar to that of neighboring buildings as well, making the new building more harmonious with its neighbors.
