Objection. We note that the applicant may claim as precedent the neighbouring addition at no. 27, granted in 2013 under reference 2013/0809/P (following 2012/6502/P). We note that while granted, there was no explanation for the Councilâs decision which was contrary to our advice.

We object to the current proposal on similar grounds. We object to the destructive nature of the proposed main rear extension, noting, again, that the rear wall forms part of the original, and surviving, form of the house and its pair. The rear extension is harmful to the original footprint and also clearly contradicts PH27. It also clearly destroys the sense of enclosure of a traditional solid masonry house, again harming the larger conservation area as defined in policy guidance. The back addition should allow the legible retention of the original footprint of the house.
