Objection. While we agree that the existing dormer windows are inappropriate in materials and forms to the Listed Buildings, we advise that their replacements as proposed are also inappropriate in terms of the proportions of the window subdivisions and the size of the framing itself which is heavy and disproportionate compared to the surviving windows in the rest of the buildings.

We would advise that timber vertical sliding-sash windows, in a traditional pattern following the main windows in the house, and with framing members also following the windows in the main elevations in scale and form could be acceptable, and could also be double-glazed to meet

modern insulation standards.

The rear door proposed is unacceptable on the same
