Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Thank you for consulting the Trust regarding this application and Listed Building Consent at the Shaftesbury Theatre.

We have no objections to this proposal, which will help support the implementation and ongoing protection and maintenance of the theatre's new and more efficient ventilation/conditioning and replacement roof coverings already permitted. Screening will help maintain the amenity of surrounding properties.

The proposal has negligible visual impact when viewed from street level, being only just visible from the south-west. It will be visible from higher levels of neighbouring buildings, although
