With reference to the plans submitted with your letter dated 17 September 1957 I am directed to inform you that the Council has decided to sporve such plans Regd. No. 11297 (your Nos. 538/32R, 33A, 34R, 35, 36, 37R, 38R, 39R, 40R, 41 and 42R), as a variation from the plan previously approved by letter dated 25 June 1957, in connection with the eraction of a three and eight-storay building, including basement, on the sites of Nos. 65-87 Hampatead hord and Nos. 146-152 Drumsond Streat, St. Fancras, for use as garage, shops, showroom and offices, in respect of the lift-motor room fronting on to Hampstead Road and Drummond Street; the omission of part of the sixth floor fronting on to Drummond Street; the omission of the loading bay and the details of the Sol's Arms Fublic House.

I have to inform you (1) of the necessity of complying with he conditions contained in the Council's letter of permission deted July 1957 in respect of the above buildings with the exception of condition 4, (2) of the desirability of keeping all flumbing, except reinwater pipes, within the building and not being brought out on to any elevation, (3) that the western staircase news Drummond Street must be carried up to serve the roof over the fifth floor and that the short office storey over the fifth floor of the Drummond Street wing must be entered from the ventilated lotby and not, as shown, from the staircase.
