It is important to fell it before it dies with all the risks thereto, and would be a danger to tree surgeons to work on. It is very close to buildings and if it fell it would cause alot of damage to these structures

My garden is about 8m by 10m and there are other mature trees in the garden. #1 hawthorn. #3 Laburnum and #1 Rowan. There is also a young bay tree and an elder tree
