




Proposed 14 no. (replacement) posts & chains with new ground finishes to footpath at entrance to 1 Holly Village, London N6 6QJ







footpath elevation (CI to C5) at I:50 (@ A3) & C 6 to C I2




Oak post & collar: as original (CI)

Ground level rises from CI(TBM) +/-0.000 to CII at +0.535mm




Garden proposal: low hedge, gravel and planting
