Thank you for the opportunity to comment. I strongly support the application to carry out this work in full.

The canopies of the Ash (T1) and both Limes (T2 and T3) have grown to the point where they currently tower rather alarmingly over not only No 9 Adamson Road directly behind 35A Buckland Crescent where the trees are, but also partially [REDACTED] No 11 Adamson Road, lying diagonally behind the garden of 35A. This is all the more pronounced as the ground in Buckland Crescent lies quite a few feet higher than Adamson Road, so that on this side the trees appear even taller in relation to our houses than they do viewed from the gardens of Buckland Crescent where they are growing.

The height and spread of these three trees, which in high winds sometimes shed branches into our gardens, has become an increasing concern in the last few years. Knowing that the Ash is additionally now showing signs of decay and that were any significant part of it to weaken and fall in this direction it could cause enormous damage, I support in full the application to carry out as a high priority work needed to make it safe; and to bring it and the Limes to a lower and more compact shape where they will be a pleasing amenity for us all instead of a source of worry. The work proposed to the Hornbeams too will greatly improve their appearance viewed from the Adamson Road gardens.
