The applicant wishes to discharge conditions 4a and 4c (Details of plumbing and stone basement surface materials (condition 4(a & c) in relation to 2017/3179/L (erection of rear single storey extension to existing closet wing at ground floor level with terrace above; relocation of existing AC units on rear

elevation to roof level and external cabinet; and internal alterations on all levels)

Material has been provided demonstrating how the underfloor heating will not affect the special interest of the listed building and condition 4a is discharged.

Drawings have also been provided demonstrating that no stone flooring either exists or is currently proposed for the basement. Consequently this condition is not capable of being discharged at this time, although should any stone flooring be applied in the basement in future, it will apply.

Condition 4b remains outstanding. (A sample of the proposed stone hall flooring material sufficiently large to indicate any pattern showing an appropriately traditional design for a house of this rate and age).
