



New fence to replace existing fence - in poor state of repair
Fence to match existing rear fence

Single brick raised bed. 200mm high
Bricks to match hotel building

Existing surface to remain. Reinstate paving where raised planter removed

Bespoke wooden planters to reflect new ecopod. Planters of castors to enable flexible use of space. Planters 700mm high

Single brick raised bed. 200mm high
Bricks to match hotel building

Western Red Cedar benches to provide informal seating area

Existing part concrete part gravel surface to be replaced with permeable brick pavers colour matched with hotel building

Existing pergola to be removed, and replaced with new pergola to create a secluded seating area

New planting area: 34m²
The planting will follow a relaxed, low maintenance scheme, with an emphasis on trees and shrubs that will increase biodiversity

Existing raised bed extended to tie into architecture of building and provide additional planting area. Single brick retaining wall to 200mm high.

Existing palms trees to be replaced with trees that offer greater biodiversity and suit the character of the building
