The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The proposed extension, by reason of its location, height, and bulk would appear as an overbearing and visually intrusive addition, which would fail to preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the host building, the wider terrace, or this part of the South Hill Park Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies DH1 and DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan (2018).
- The proposed extension, by reason of its location, height, and bulk, would cause unacceptable harm to the amenity of the neighbouring residential occupiers by way

of loss of outlook and increased enclosure, contrary to policy A1 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and policy DH1 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan (2018).

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2018.
