

## 22 PRINCESS ROAD

## Dear Mr Marfleet

As owner the first floor flat , 24 Princess Road , I will add my strong objections to this development plan .

I am certain that the correct notice time has not been given by posted street notice . I have been in residence every day for the last month and have only seen the yellow notice in the last week . And then with difficulty as it had been moved to ANKLE level facing out into the street of parked cars , so invisible to all passers by .

I have moved this back twice this week before Wednesday , only to find it back in the invisible. position described very soon after .

My conclusion is that the planning applicant does not want the notice viewed .

The second concern , as with process, is setting a precedent for this type of underground tunnelling and living . And these Victorian houses were not designed for the sewage and drainage required for multi occupation of4 flats per dwelling let alone adding more works to the system . Then there is the HS2 requisition of all the cellars of this side of Princess Road . To my knowledge this has not been rescinded so would make any development pointless as it would be demolished by the takeover .

So in conclusion I am strongly against such extra below pavement development and truly believe the correct planning application notice procedure has been tampered with .
