As discussed I need to get a section 211 planning act was it? permission to allow the pruning of my tree to go ahead.

My name is Sean Titley

The address where the tree is located is 73A Roderick Road, London, NW3 2NP. The tree is in the back garden and visible from Savernake Road.

I, Sean Titley, am the owner of the property with a leasehold which includes the garden and the land on which the tree sits.

The work I need to do is remove a primary limb on the South Side, due to it being dead (presumably from disease) and to reduce the remaining crown by up to 2.5 metres.

As an aside, thinking back I think you are correct about the leaves being a yellowish colour, certainly by the time they fall anyway. The colour would also tally with it being called a Honey Locust tree too !

Can you let me know when it is ok for me to proceed with the work, most grateful,
