As a neighbour, I consider the tree to be of great amenity value: it contributes to the green outlook to rear of Arlington Road which is made up of Grade II listed buildings and it is home to a variety of birds, wildlife and possibly bats. Removing this tree would be detrimental to the conservation area and its loss would not be compensated for by other trees in the vicinity. I consider that the tree report is light on detail and does not substantiate how the tree is 'diseased', structurally dangerous or given a category A, B or C status to its life expectancy - merely that it may not tolerate further pollarding. The tree was pollarded by a previous owner and therefore would not need to be reduced again for many years. In conclusion, before the tree is removed I would urge the council to fully assess the quality of the tree and its amenity value and not allow it to be felled simply because it may be inconveniently located for the applicant.
