## The London Building Acts, 1930 and 1935. 57. Charlotte Street. St. Cancras.

I have been directed to intimate to you the Council's decision, which is as follows:-

That observance of the by-laws relating to lamps, signs or other structures overhanging the public way, in force under Section 12 of the London Building Act (Amendment) Act, 1935, be dispensed with so far as relates to the erection of a clock at 57, Charlotte Street, St. Pancras, as shown on the plan (No. 39434) submitted in connection with the application of Telephone Bentals (Telematic) Ltd., on behalf of Mesars. Levrey's Laundry, the dispensation being subject to the following conditions:-

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- (1) that the work shall be commenced with three wonths and completed within six months from the first day of August, 1937;
- (2) that the lighting of the clock shall be non-intermittent in character;
- (3) that the projection of the clock and supports shall be reduced so as not to exceed 4 feet from the main front wall of the building to which it is ettached;
- (4) that seven clear days before the erection of the clock notice in writing of intention to erect the clock shall be given to the Local Authority;
- (5) that the whole of the work shall be executed to the satisfaction of the District Surveyor; and
- (6) that the clock shall be otherwise erected and retained without any addition thereto and in exact accordance with the application for the dispensation and the said plan and particulars submitted in connection with such spalication.
