## Assessment

The proposal is to regularise the external seating area at this restaurant, which at present has a step halfway out in the area. The proposal would make the seating raised to the extent of the private area, which would be tiled. There would also be modest wrought iron balustrade to either flank, with small returns to the street, and to delineate the access to the central residential door. No other alterations are proposed. The proposal would not be detrimental to the CA, and is considered acceptable.

The objections of the Charlotte Street CAAC have been noted but officers do not consider that any material harm to the character of the Conservation Area will arise as a result of the approval of this application.
