Proposal: Display of 2 x non-illuminated projecting "V" signs (3m in height by 0.6 in width and 0.58m in depth) at 2no floor level and 2 x internally illuminated (halo) lettering fascia signs (1.8m in width by 0.36m in height and 0.2m in depth) at 1st floor level to the front elevation, and 1 x internally illuminated (halo) lettering sign (6m in height by 1.02m in width by 0.2m in depth) between 1st and 3rd floor level to side elevation.

The Bloomsbury Association object to this proposal on the grounds of public safety and wish to make the following comments.

The proposed display presents a risk to public safety in that it is of a size and a prominence that, as is intended, will distract the attention of drivers approaching the junction of Euston Road, Tottenham Court Road and Hampstead Road. At this point there are traffic light controlled pedestrian crossings which are all too easy for drivers to miss. It should be noted that the West End Project proposes that traffic on Tottenham Court Road will shortly become two-way.

We note that no drawing accompanies the proposal.

The Association supports good quality design that will enhance Bloomsbury's streetscape. With such a demonstrable breach of the Council's planning policy and of its supplementary planning guidance, we look to the Council to refuse this application.

We would be grateful if you would let us know of any further modification to the application; the decision, if it is to be decided under delegated powers, or the meeting date if it is to be decided by Committee.
