Thank you for allowing me to send you my objection to planning application 2019/0133/P 33 Harmood Street NW1 8DW

I object on the basis that in order for this further extension of this semi detached 1996 built property, it would require the removal of shrubs which are home to a colony of house sparrows, the RSPB have stated that house sparrow population has declined by 60% especially in urban areas. The owner landlord directed a gardening company to remove the shrubs approximately 3 years ago when he registered his previous planning extension. Fortunately a neighbour intervened and the gardeners stopped without causing too much damage to the sparrows. They continue to flourish undisturbed.
