NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 2 x Bay (T1 & T2) - Reduce crown by 25%

FRONT GARDEN: 2 x Bay (T3 & T4) - Reduce height to match neighbouring bay and trim
back front face on both trees 0.25m.

1 x Sumach (T5) - Light formative prune 0.3m

1 x Sorbus (T6) - Reduce crown by 25% to natural flowing canopy line

1 x Cherry (T7) - Light reduction by 20% to suitable growth points

1 x Laburnum (T8) - Reduce by 25% to shape

1 x Holm Oak (T9) - Reduce height by 25% (1.3m) to suitable growth points and cut back
side growth to balance 0.75m

1 x Mulberry (T10) - Light prune to shape 0.4m

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 07 January
2019 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is

- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
