Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Magnolia - Reduce crown by 20% and shape.

1 x Fig - Reduce crown by 15%, reduce overhang from roadside and shape.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Sweet Bay - Raise crown to first main fork, reduce height by 2 metres and shape crown.

1 x Myrtle - Shape and reduce by a maximum of 10% to allow for growth.

1 x Mulberry - Reduce overhang from neighbouring garden at rear back to boundary line, and shape crown to maintain a good balance.

SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Holly - Raise crown and shape/trim by 15%

1 x self-seeded Ash - light reduction to previous points.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 10 January 2019 and does not wish to object.


