The Earl of Camden has undergone a programme of refurbishment which we welcome as it improves the overall environment at the junction of Parkway and Albert Street. As part of the refurbishment they have installed neon high level signage on the Parkway and Albert St faces of the building. This is new signage and has not been subject to planning approval and is totally out of keeping with the current streetscape. We also contend that: 1. Albert street is in a protected area/conservation zone 2. That status guards against development that is not in keeping with the local environment. 3. This signage breaches that protection 4. This protection was enforced recently against Fitness First who also installed inappropriate signage to the Albert St face of the building.
