Proposal:

(TPO REF. C18A-T07) REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime (T1) - Fell to ground level and treat stump.

(TPO REF. C1189 2017) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x False Acacia (T3) - Fell to ground level and treat stump.

The Council has considered your application dated 13 December 2018 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.



- All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)
 - Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
- Prior to the end of the next available planting season following the completion of works, 1 no. Amelanchier lamarkii, 12-14cm in girth (single stemmed) tree shall be planted in the front garden of the property at least 1m away from any structure. 2 no. Betula pendula, 12-14cm in girth shall be planted in the rear garden of the property at least 1m from any structure unless otherwise agreed in the writing with the council. The trees shall be planted and maintained in line with BS 8545:2014.

Reason: To ensure that the replanting achieves a high quality of landscaping which contributes to the visual amenity and character of the area, in accordance with the requirements of policies A2 and A3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

Informative(s):

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
