Dear Mr Lawlor,

I would like to put an objection forward about application 2018/6267/P.

The open terrace on the first floor and the walkway to adjacent building back the enclosed courtyard, to the residential area.

The refurbishment of Aviation House has started in September 2018 and still ongoing, and as far I understand it they do not have planning permission to carry out such jobs.

I have been in contact with Rita Darbar the Environmental Officer since beginning of November 2018 case ref:SR 247896 she has managed to have the new heating and ventilation plant (also installed without prior planning consent) switched off in the evening and weekends, but since then they are still working on it and no sound proofing yet.

I want to ask you to have a closer look at the impact of the noise, the proposed walkway and terrace is going to have on the residents, as a disabled person I spend quite some time in my flat and find the noise level has increased exponentially in the past few years all coming from construction work and careless attention to the rules of good neighbourliness.

I have tried to talk to the manager of WeWork three times but to no avail, as you well know the management has decided to open the place in spite of the refurbishment not being finished so there is constant noise coming from the construction works, even on weekends, and the noise from the day to day maintenance.
