2.1 Number 17 Branch Hill is located just south of the West Heath within Hampstead Conservation Area.

3.0 Relevant Planning History

3.1 Application Ref: 2015/3377/P Erection of part 2 and part 3 storey plus basement single family dwelling (following demolition of existing) with plant room, swimming pool (including air handling unit) and 5 condenser units.

4.0 Description of Proposed Development

4.1 The proposal involves the construction of a carport, with a flat roof in lieu of existing.

- 5.1 The existing carport could accomodate 3 cars, but due to structure it was not fully functional.
